





Never direct the muzzle towards a person, animal or other dangerous directions.




Select a safe place for operating the air gun, avoiding places where people and cars pass cross or third persons are around.

Make sure to attach the barrel end safety cap to Make sure to attach the barrel end safety cap to the muzzle, except when you shooting, for preventing accidental, sudden discharge and for the dust proof propose. Never pull the trigger with the barrel end safety cap being attached.

Safety procedure:

- 1 Attach the safety cap to the muzzle.
  2 Set the selector lever to the safety position.
  3 Remove the magazine.
  4 Remove the battery.



Looking in to the muzzle is extremely dangerous, regardless of with or without BBs being installed.

If a BB bullet hits your eye, you may in the worst case, loose your sight.



Activating the trigger carelessly is extremely dangerous. Never put your finger onto the trigger unless the safety cap is removed and you are ready to shoot a target.



When shooting the air guns for a target or game, when shooting the air guns for a target or game, you and all participants must wear goggle or other eye protective gear, also playing attention to ricochets. Pay sufficient attention also to third personnel other then participants.



There are cases that BBs remain in the gun after the magazine is disconnected. After removal of the magazine, direct the muzzle towards a safe direction and pull the trigger to confirm that no BBs remain in the gun, then attach the safety cap.



Always attach the safety cap to the muzzle, remove the battery and store the air gun in a case or bag and at a place out of reach by children.






THE RECEIVER IS MARKED IN MILLIMETERS FOR EASY USE.









## SPRING RELEASE





FOR NORMAL USE: Turn(do not push) the selector backward to release the spring.



WHEN DISASSEMBLED: Pull the release lever (on left side of gear box) to release the spring.

### CAUTION

Always attache the safety cap and disconnected the magazine to avoid sudden operation upon connecting battery.

Be careful so as not to catch your fingers in the movable parts.

Always set the lever to "safe" before firing.

Do not disassemble beyond what is necessary, or the gun may be damaged.

Always use "G&G ARMAMENT" BBs for this gun, we shell not be held responsible for any damage or accidents arising from the use of bullets supplied by other manufacturers.

Since a tight barrel is used, use of dirty BBs or those with burrs causes jamming and possible fatal damage to the gear box.

Turning hop-up dial excessively cause clogging of bb, keep pulling trigger with bb clogged damages the piton and gears.

Never hold the gun sideways as bb will curve right or left.

We shell not be held responsible for any damage or accidents arising from the wrong operation or modification.

Disassembly is designed for appropriate maintenance, not for modification.
