Important Green Gas Information

The filling temperature of the both green gas source and magazine should be at least 21°C (70F) in order to get max number of shots from your pistol. For optimal performance, user should not fill the magazine when it is cold.



SR-1911 PARTS DESCRIPTION





GAS VER. MAGAZINE LOADING BBS & GAS INJECTION



PRESS THE MAGAZINE CATCH AND REMOVE THE MAGAZINE BY PULLING IT DOWNWARD.

LOADING BBS

AWARNING TURN THE SAFETY LEVEL SELECTOR TO SAFE MODE. KEEP THE SELECTOR ON SAFE MODE UNTIL YOU ARE READY TO SHOOT.

AWARNING

GREEN GAS IS FLAMMABLE. **KEEP AWAY FROM OPEN FLAME** WHEN LOADING AND DURING USE.

CO2 VER. MAGAZINE INSTALLING CO2 CARTRIDGE & LOADING BBS



- TURN THE MAGAZINE UPSIDE DOWN WITH GAS REFILL INLET FACING UPWARDS.
- KEEPING THE GAS CYLINDER INVERTED AND VERTICAL TO THE MAGAZINE, INJECT GAS UNTIL COMPLETELY FILLED.

TURN THE SCREW CLOCKWISE TO PUNCTURE THE CO2 CARTRIDGE, LOADING BBs.



Click

INSERT THE MAGAZINE UNTIL YOU HEAR IT CLICK INTO PLACE.
THE GUN IS NOW READY TO FIRE.

SHOOTING



ALWAYS KEEP YOUR FINGER OFF THE TRIGGER UNTIL YOU ARE READY TO FIRE THE GUN. MAKE SURE THE MUZZLE IS ALWAYS POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION.



PULL THE SLIDE BACKWARDS AND RELEASE.



ALLOWING THE PISTOL TO FIRE IN SEMI-AUTOMATIC MODE.

DISAEMBLE SLIDE



2.PULL BACK ON THE SLIDE AND HOLD LIKE SHOWN ABOVE.



PUSH THE SLIDE RELEASE BUTTON.











SR-1911 SCHEMATIC
