## AT2000 Tracer Module

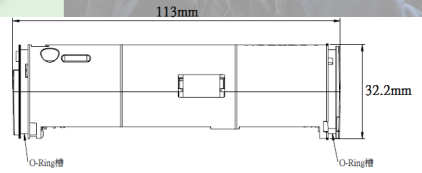

### Description

1. AT2000 is a tracer module and should be used with the silencer. As long as the silencer's internal space can accommodate the AT2000 module, the AT2000 module can be installed into the silencer and then the silencer can be used as a tracer unit.



2. AT2000 module is equipped with infrared sensors at its both ends, which can detect airsoft pellets, so the AT2000 module can be inserted in the silencer in any direction according to user's preference and the silencer's type appearance.  
3. While installing, the inner sponge and spring must be removed from the silencer.

- If the diameter of silencer's inner aperture is longer than of AT2000 module's, please use O-rings or round bushings so that the AT2000 modules and the silencer can be coaxial/with the same axle.
- If AT2000 modules is not coaxial with the silencer, airsoft pellets would misfit the internal tube of the AT2000 module and probably damage the internal components and bodies structure.
- A4 AAA Alkaline batteries or heavy duty Ni-CD rechargeable batteries need to be installed to the AT2000 module. After correctly installing to the silencer and attaching to the target gun, users can switch on the power to use the device.
- Automatic switching off in following conditions:
  - Device has idled for 40 minutes
  - When the battery power is low, after the power indicator blinks in red color for 3 seconds, device is turned off.
- Remaining power indication
  - Green light: high power
  - Orange light: medium power
  - Red light: low power
- Do not disassemble the AT2000 module to prevent high voltage electrical shot.
- Do not look straight to the muzzle to check the installation of the device to prevent any accident from misfiring.

### Battery usage requirements:

- Must be Alkaline batteries for non rechargeable batteries.
- Do not use heavy duty batteries. it affects on the performance of AT2000.
- Take out the batteries if device will not be used for some time.
- In case of using rechargeable battery, high quality brands like Eneloop, Panasonic, and etc are recommended.
