

1 User Instruction

1. Always use Classic Army silicone oil: spray a few drops into the chamber from the magazines entrances.

2.Always use Classic Army 6mm BB pellets. Use of other manufacturer's pellets or recycle use of pellets may cause pellet clog (jamming or possibly fatal damage to the gear box. Classic Army shall not be held responsible for any damage or accidents arising from the use of BB pellets supplied by other manufacturers or use of recycle BB pellets.

3.Use Classic Army specified 8.4V battery and charger for the AEG.

4.Use the specified battery and charge according to respective instruction manuals. Classic Army will not be held responsible for any damage or accidents arising from wrongful or usage of non-specified battery and charger.

5.Do "NOT" disassemble or modify the AEG.. This AEG is manufactured under consideration of appropriate performance, operability and maintenance. Disassembling or modifying the AEG may be dangerous, may adversely affect its performance and may be damaged.

6. Give the AEG a rest for 5 to 10 minutes after firing about 500 rounds, in order to prevent the overheat of the motor and battery as well as to ensure long service life of it.

7. Immediately STOP any operation, when the BB pellets are clogged or the gear box has overly loud operating noise.

8.Please discharge the battery before it is recharge again.

9.Be aware of the weather changing, STOP operation immediately when it is raining or when the AEG is wet; also disconnect the battery.

10. Be aware of unnecessary collision to your AEG.

11.Do NOT wear a damaged safety goggles. Please note that Classic Army safety goggle can resist up to 1.5 joules muzzle energy.

12.Immediately remove the magazine and disconnect the battery, when the AEG is firing out of control.

2 Warranty Instruction

1. Always use Classic Army silicone oil and the cleaning rod to clean the Inner Barrel.

2.Please remember to keep your warranty card against maintenances.

3. Please use prompt amount of silicone oil. Excess use of silicone oil will caused corrosion or damage to the AEG.

4. Avoid over exposure of your AEG under the sun.

5.Be aware of unnecessary collision to your AEG.

6.Please discharge the battery before it is recharge again.

7.After 20.000 Rrounds of BB pellets had been shoot out from the AEG, please consult our dealer for the needs of regular maintenance or repair.

Aways read through this manual before operation.


3 Maintenance Instruction

1. If the AEG is not working, please check if the connector is connected properly, and that the fuse is not blown out.

2. If the fired pellets spread in an unusal direction, please check whether the "Hop-up" packing is damaged or not.

3.Do "NOT" disassemble or modify the AEG. This AEG is manufactured under consideration of appropriate performance, operability and maintenance. Disassembling or modifying the AEG may be dangerous, may adversely affect its performance and may be damaged. Please consult our dealer for any disassembly, product enhancement, maintenance or repair.

1 Magazine Attachment / Detachment Procedure

· Action against problem

Failure in pellet feeding may occasionally occur during full auto operation. In this case, disconnect the magazine, give a slight shock or poke BB pellets using a stick and then set the magazine again.

About 30 pellets will remain in the duct after operation. Be careful with the pellets which will fire out if you hold the gun upside-down and pull the trigger.

Ensure Smooth Pellet Feeding

- · Occasionally give slight shocks to the gun or shake vertically to ensure smooth pellet feeding.
- . Slightly turn the gear after every 50 to 60 pellets to
 - ensure smooth pellet feeding.



Open the top hatch and insert BB pellets. About 330 pellets can be aded. (Avoid forcing BB pellets

5. Check the BB pellets whether they are lifted up to the exit, and then connect the magazine to the gun



If pellet feeding is frequently in fault, remove all pellets from the magazine and spray silicone oil for 1 to 2 sec. Note that the hop-up operation may become unstable for a while after using silicone oil.

4 How to fold the grip



1, Pull the grip downward and fold the grip under the barrel.



2. Three positions can be used.

6 How to fire

1. Switch the selector switch to Semi or Full Auto



* Blank firing may occur after setting the magazine, this is the normal operation of the gun

Change the battery if the firing cycle becomes slow Give the air gun a rest for 5 to 10 minutes after firing about 500 pellets, in order to ensure high durability of the motor and battery.

If pellets are clogged, remove them and apply a few drops of silicone oil into chamber from the magazine entrance as shown or spray silicone oil for 0.5 to 1 sec to obtain smooth continuous fring. (Never use CRC-556 or other

(i) How to adjust the hop up system




- Continue pulling the cocking lever while adjusting the lever.
- 2 Turn the hop up adjustment lever gradually.
- 3 Turning excessively will adversely affect the trajectory. Stop turning the hop up adjustment lever when pellets fly horizontally.
 - Over turning towards the hop up will cause pellets clogging easily. Keep pulling the trigger with clogged pellets will damage the piston and gears.

The port cover may be removed and attached to the left ejection port

6 Maintenance

1 How to use a cleaning rod





Cut a cotton cloth to the size as shown above and insert one end into the hole of the rod.

(Adjust the length of cloth for smooth entry into the barrel)

Hold the tip of the rod and insert it with turning motion



CALITION: Always begin the maintenance by returning the hop up adjustment lever to NORMAL


CALITION: The chamber is a precision component Never use any used BB pellets. ance may become unstable for 60 to 70 peliets after main

Inserting the rod will be difficult if you hold the rod at the end.

AUG A2 & AUG A2 (Short Version)

- Spray silicone oil for 0.5 to 1 sec in the pellet entrance, then fire 40 to 50 pellets to make the magazine stable.
- To complete the maintenance, clean the oil from the chamber by using the clean rod.



7 Normal Disassembly for Overhaul



- Pull the cocking handle and hook it to the receiver nail.
- Press down the barrel lock button at an angle and maintain it there.
- Viewing from the front. Turn the barrel assembly counterclockwise (about 20 degrees)
- Slowly pull out the barrel assembly to the front.

20A Glass Tube Fuse is used

2 How to Assemble the Barrel Assembly






Press the barrel lock button and keep pressing it down.

- Press in the barrel assembly, aligning the projection in the assembly with the cutout in the receiver.
 - ② Turn the barrel assembly so that the rib of the assembly is located at the front edge of the receiver.

(3) How to Remove and Assemble the Receiver





Remova

- Press the take-down latch from the circle marked position to a position where a click sound is generated (about 1 cm). (Becareful not to press it too much.)
- Pull out the receiver towards the front. (Becareful not to hook the projection in the receiver to the spring in the stock and above the trigger.)


