2 Magazine Attachment / Detachment Procedure

High precision is required for the operation of this magazine. Avoid invasion of dust and dirt into the magazine to prevent malfunctions.

- Action against problem
Failure in pellet feeding may occasionally occur during full auto operation. In this case, disconnect the magazine, give a slight shock or poke BB pellets using a stick and then set the magazine again.

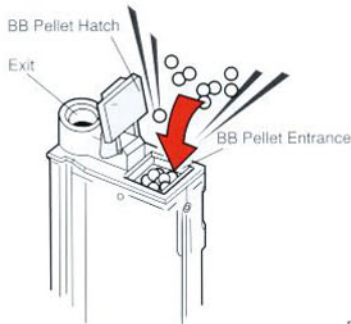


About 20 pellets remain in the duct after operation. Be careful of any pellets firing out if you hold the gun up-side-down and pull the trigger.

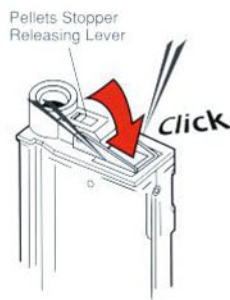
Ensure smooth pellet feeding.

- Occasionally give slight shocks to the gun or shake vertically to ensure smooth pellet feeding.
- Slightly turn the gear every 50 to 60 pellets to ensure smooth pellet feeding.

- 1 Open the top hatch and insert BB pellets. About 200 pellets can be loaded. (Avoid forcing BB pellets into the magazine.)



- 2 Close the hatch

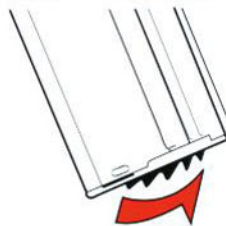


Remove pellets remaining in the duct by reversing the magazine and using the release lever as shown. This ensures smooth operation next time.

- 3 Hold the Magazine with BB pellet entrance facing upward and turn the gear at the bottom all the way until the click-click sounds change. (If only a small number of BB pellets are inserted, the gear merely makes blank turning.)

Turn the gear all the way until the sound changes.

The gear will not be damaged even if you turn it excessively.



- 4 Check whether the BB pellets are lifted up to the exit, and then connect the magazine to the gun.

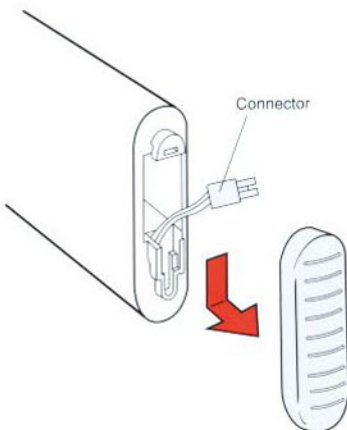

When pellets are clogged

- Remove them and apply a few drops of silicone oil into chamber from the magazine entrance as shown or spray silicone oil for 0.5 to 1 sec. to obtain smooth continuous firing. (never use CRC-556 or other mineral oil)



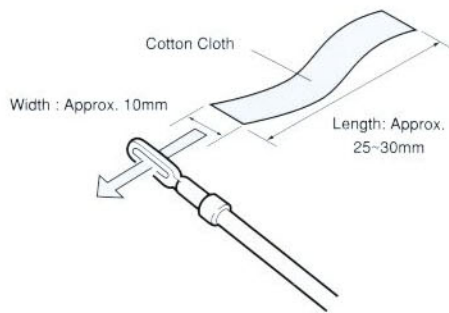

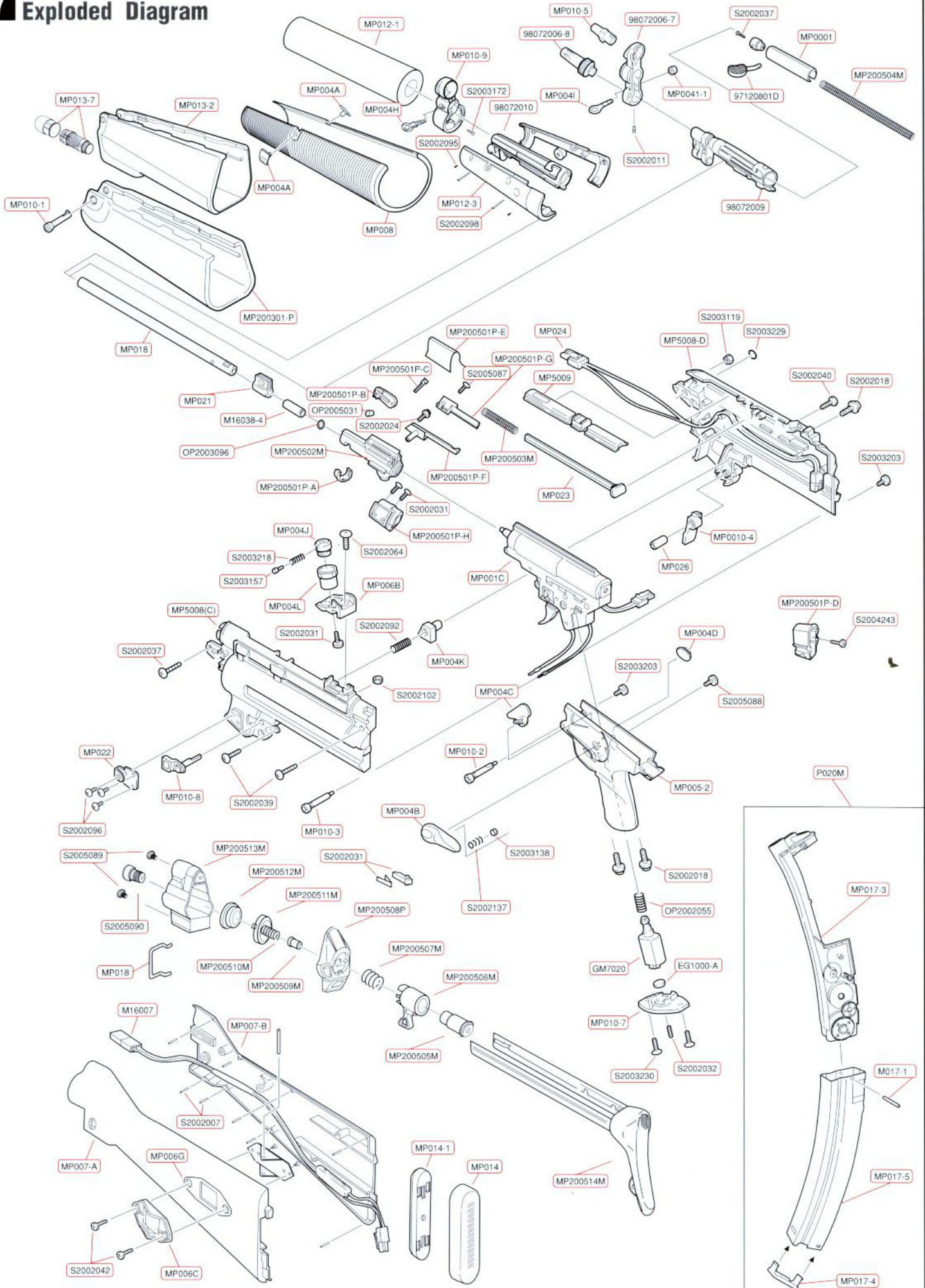
