1. DESCRIPTION AND OPERATION

1.1 MODELS

The full licensed Kalashnikov USA KR-9 SBR AEG series comes in the sub-machine configuration with a 1:1 scale based on the Russian PP-19-01 "Vityaz." Includes a detachable mid-cap magazine which is available in 9 x 19 millimeter. Models, specifications are subject to change.



The **KP-9** is a USA designed 9mm AK style sub-machine gun. It is based on the Russian Vityaz-SN submachine gun, accepts 9x19 mm magazines. The KP-9 comes with attached picatinny railing, deans wired connector, and attached folding stock.

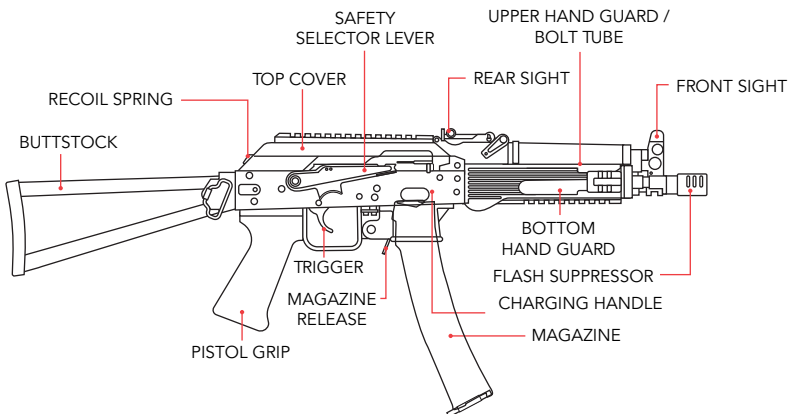

2. DESIGNATED OPERATION

2.1 LOADING THE MAGAZINE

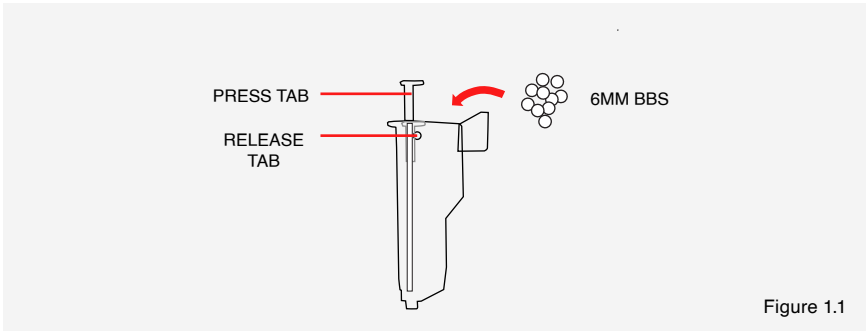

FIGURE 1.1 — SPEED LOADER DIAGRAM

- As shown in Figure 1.1, with the magazine, PRESS the RELEASE TAB on the speed loader marked “PUSH OPEN” to release the PRESS TAB. Open the lid marked “OPEN” and load BBS into the speed loader chamber until full.

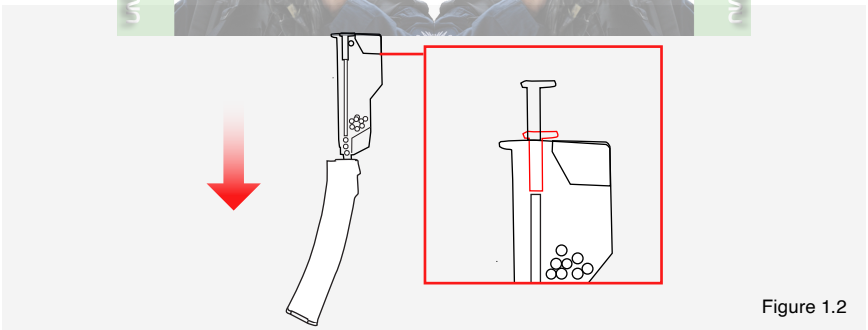

FIGURE 1.2 — LOADING THE MAGAZINE

- As shown in Figure 1.2, hold the BB speedloader vertical to the magazine and firmly PRESS the nozzle to the magazine opening, then PRESS down on the PRESS TAB pushing BBs into the magazine until full.



CAUTION

CAUTION - Do not overfill the magazine. The magazine holds approximately 90 BBs. Over filling may cause damage to the magazine's internals and may BB feeding issues. Additionally, extended storage of a loaded magazine will, over-time, place wear onto the springs and reduce its functional lifespan.

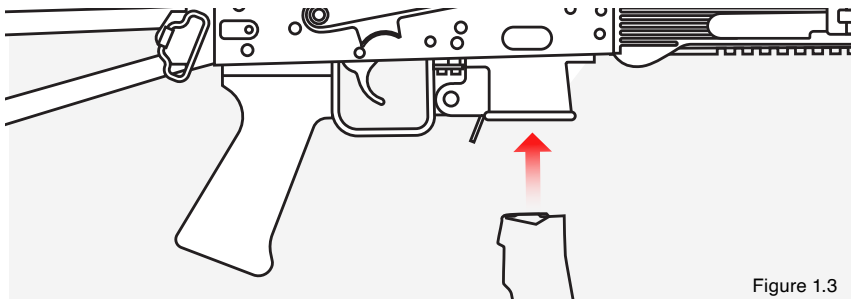

FIGURE 1.3 — LOADING THE MAGAZINE

- As shown in Figure 1.3, hold the magazine with one hand and INSERT the feeding side into the airsoft gun's MAGWELL ensuring the magazine locks firmly into place.

2.2 ADJUSTING THE HOP-UP

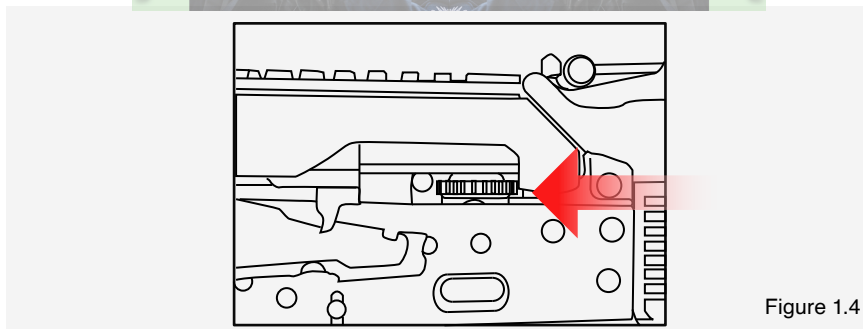

- As shown in Figure 1.4, pull the charging handle back and lock and hold it back with the SELECTOR LEVER set to "SAFE" with the ejection port cover open, adjustment to the ROTARY HOP-UP WHEEL can be made through

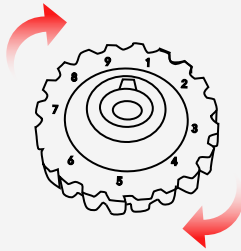

FIGURE 1.5 — THE HOP-UP ROTARY WHEEL

- As shown in Figure 1.5, the dial numbers on the ROTARY WHEEL can be viewed through either the EJECTION PORT or by raising the DUST COVER.
- The numbers on the dial indicate the level of applied Hop-Up to the BBs. Straight is set at 5, the closer to 1 the Hop-up will curve the BB down, conversely the closer to 9 the BB will curve up.

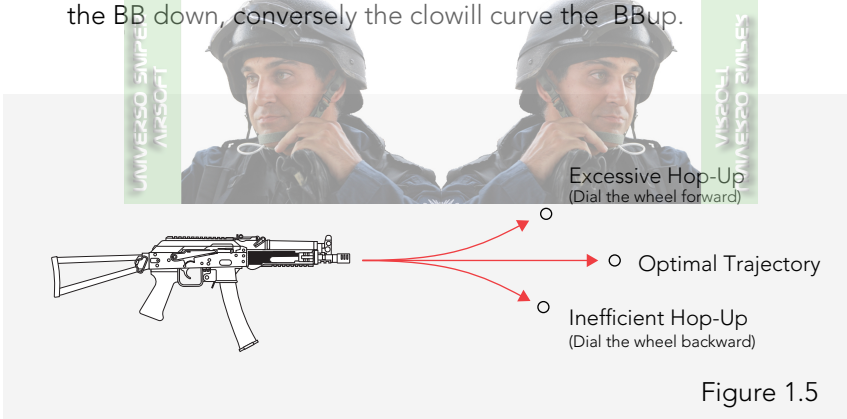

FIGURE 1.6 — TRAJECTORY AND BB HOP-UP

- As shown in Figure 1.6, the trajectory of the BB is affected by the Hop-Up placed onto the BB and the conditions of the environment (i.e wind). Take several shots as you make minor adjustments to the ROTARY HOP-UP WHEEL until the BB arches into an optimal trajectory path.

2.3 SELECTOR LEVER AND FIRE SELECTION

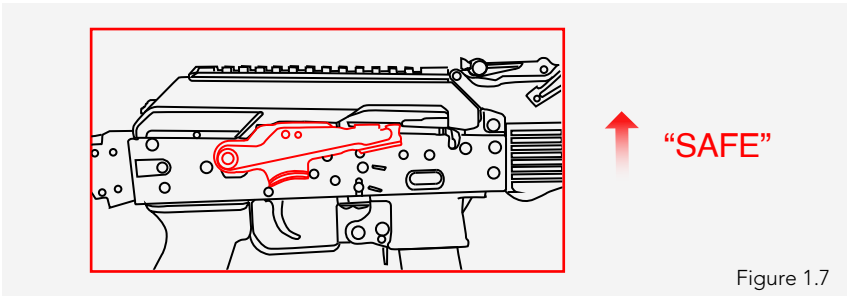


FIGURE 1.7 — SAFE

- As shown in Figure 1.7, Safe, indicated by the SELECTOR LEVER, when set to the SELECTOR LEVER is set to the TOP POSITION it will lock the trigger and prevent the airsoft gun from firing.

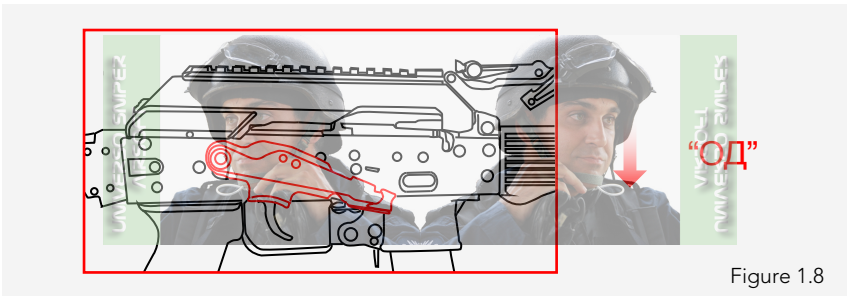


FIGURE 1.8 — SEMI-AUTOMATIC

- As shown in Figure 1.8, "SEMI-AUTOMATIC" mode, indicated by "ОД" on the SELECTOR SWITCH, will fire one single BB for each pull of the trigger.

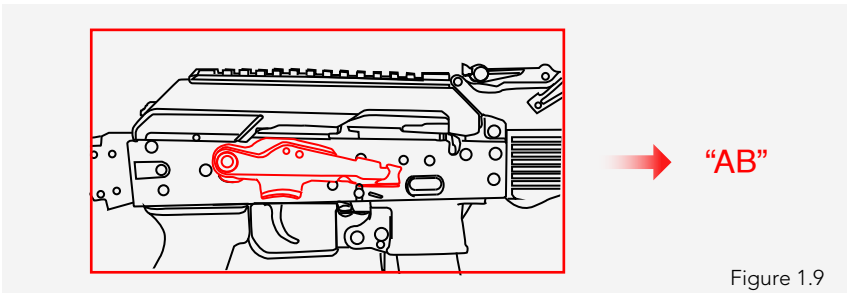


FIGURE 1.9 — FULL-AUTOMATIC

- As shown in Figure 1.9, “FULLY-AUTOMATIC” mode, indicated by “AB” on the SELECTOR SWITCH, will continuously fire as long as the TRIGGER is kept depressed and the BB ammunition feeding remains available.

2.4 CONNECTING THE LIPO BATTERY

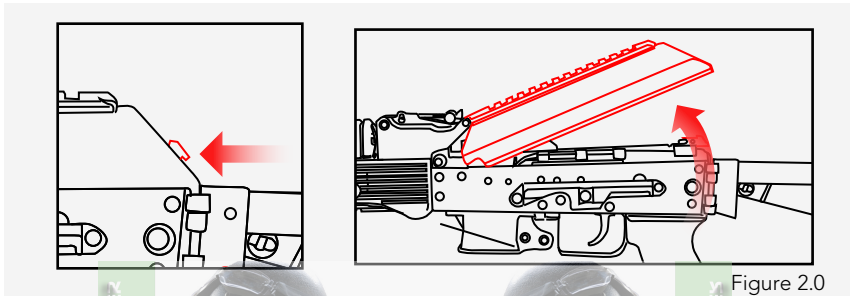

FIGURE 2.0 — OPENING THE DUST COVER

- As shown in Figure 2.0, firmly PRESS the release button located at the rear end of the DUST COVER. The cover will rise allowing access to the BATTERY STORAGE compartment.

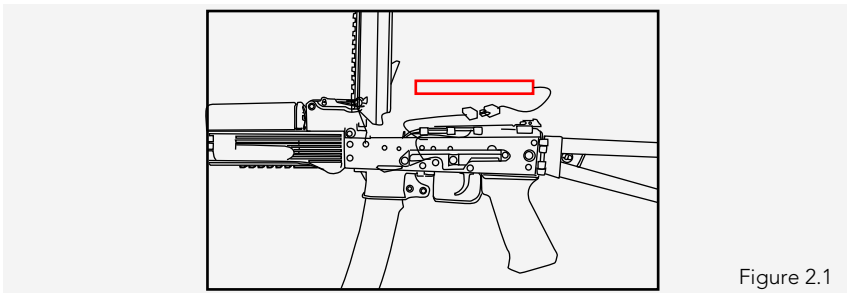

FIGURE 2.1 — CONNECTING THE BATTERY

- As shown in Figure 2.1, Connect the Deans LIPO BATTERY to the DEANS WIRED connection, placing the battery such that it lays flat along the length of the BATTERY STORAGE compartment.

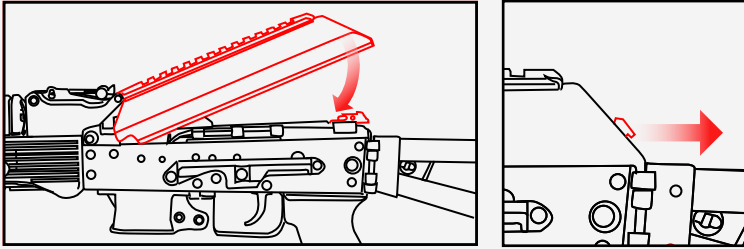

FIGURE 2.2 — CLOSING THE DUST COVER

- As shown in figure 2.2, after ensuring all wirings are tucked neatly into the BATTERY STORAGE compartment. Lower the DUST COVER back onto the receiver until the PUSH BUTTON locks into place.

CAUTION - Always adhere to all Lipo Battery safety and guidelines. Use only 11.1V 1000 mAh 15c LIPO or 11.1 V 1000 nimh or lower. If your battery is hot, swelling, warm to the touch, disconnect the battery and. Extreme fire danger. Page for all warnings.

2.4 FOLDING STOCK

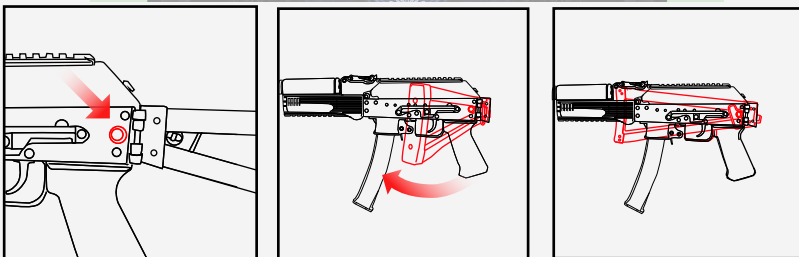

- As shown in Figure 2.3, PRESS down on the FOLDING STOCK RELEASE BUTTON, unlocking it from the locked position.
- Fold the stock back onto the airsoft gun until it attaches to the RECEIVER, firmly snapping the stock into the locked closed position.

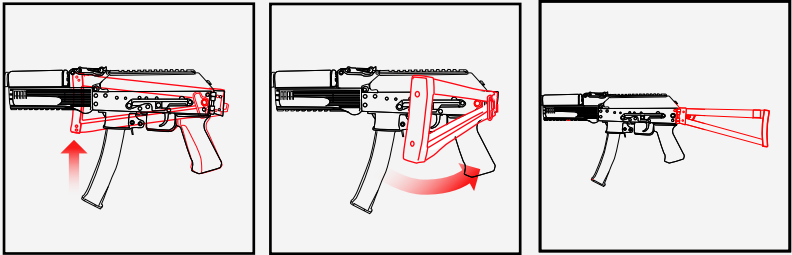

- As shown in Figure 2.4, apply upwards force to the bottom rear folding stock, pushing up to remove pressure off the retaining clasp. This will allow for the stock to release and fold back into the open position.

3. GENERAL MAINTENANCE

3.1 GENERAL

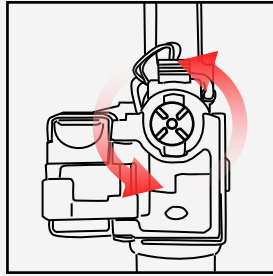
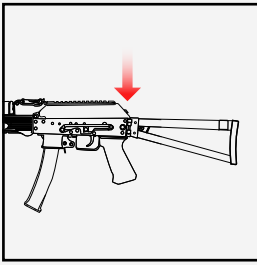
Airsoft guns, like live firearms, must be cleaned and maintained with proper gun care. An unmaintained or neglected airsoft gun could result in malfunctions, misfires, locked gears, and or become inoperable. Whether target shooting, airsofting, or simulation training; be sure to take proper care of your airsoft gun.

3.2 CLEANING AND LUBRICATION

- Periodically use a inner varrel cleaning/unjamming rod with a fabric end to clear out any debris, obstructions, or dust occumulated from prolonged storage.
- Use a small amount of silicone lubricant oil to maintain the moving parts of your airsoft gun.

3.3 QUICK CHANGE SPRING

The airsoft gun comes equipped with a quick access spring port allowing for the replacement of universal springs.

FIGURE 2.6 — QUICK CHANGE SPRING PORT

- As shown in Figure 2.6, located at the rear end of the receiver is the QUICK CHANGE SPRING PORT. CLOSE the FOLDING STOCK and LIFT the DUST COVER to access.
- Use a 2.5mm Hex Key and ROTATE the alignment cap counter-clockwise to access the cover for the Quick Change Spring.

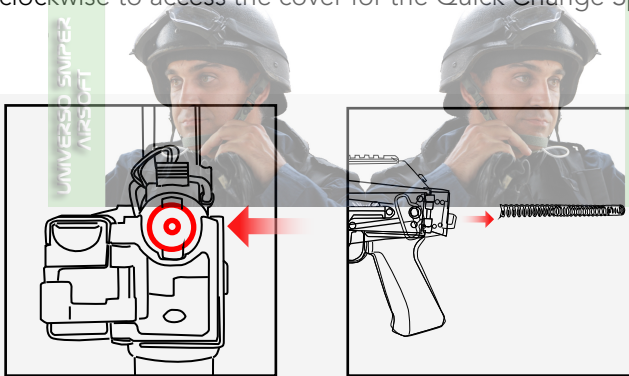

- As shown in Figure 2.7, use a slotted head screw driver to push in and release the spring. Remove and replace the with universal spring to adjust the FPS of the airsoft gun.

4. TRANSPORTATION

4.1 Transport the airsoft rifle/pistol in a carrying case to protect it from shocks and drops.

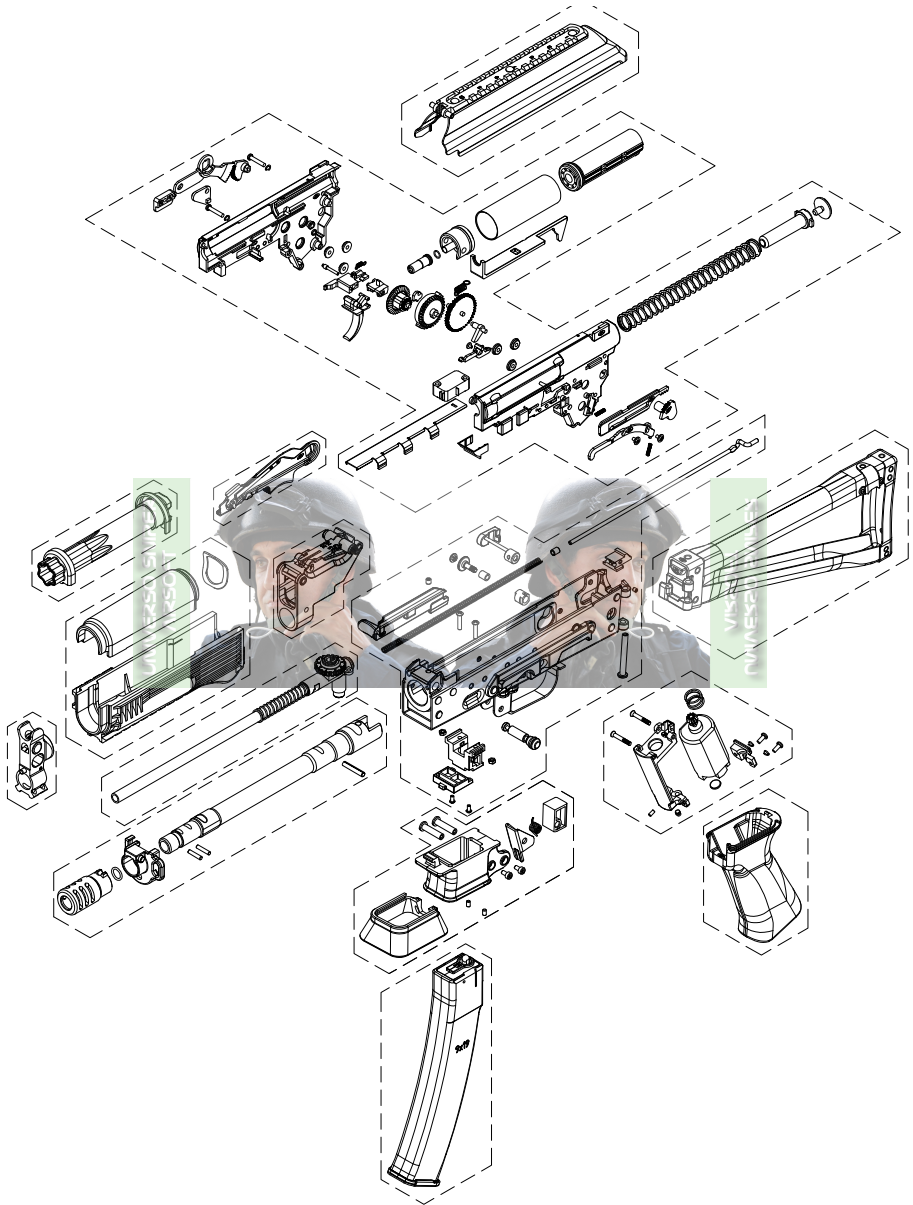
5. STORAGE

5.1 As packed by the manufacturer, store the airsoft rifle/pistol for no longer than 12 months without re-preservation (shorter periods in damp cold or humid environments).

5.2 Store the airsoft gun in dry premises without sharp temperature fluctuations, away from heating devices. Aggressive impurities should be absent in the ambient air. The airsoft gun should be always unloaded, the magazine detached and the safety should be in the (Safe) "S" position. The airsoft gun should be cleaned and lubricated before storage. Store in a gun safe or other proper secure system inaccessible to minors.

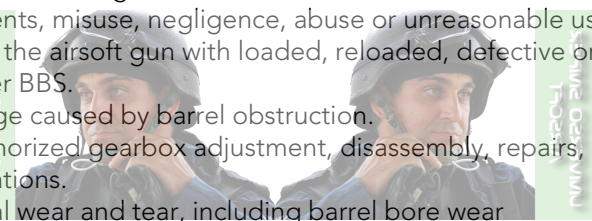
