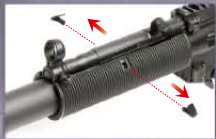

1 Pull the handguard locking pin out.



2 Remove the handguard.



3 Set the battery under the outer barrel.



1. Charge up the battery.
2. Charging will be completed after 3 hours.

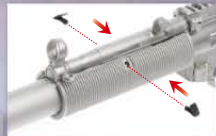
- Please select quality battery with the CE approval to avoid any unnecessary damage on the product.
- Please use either 8.4V or 9.6V battery, if different voltage used, it might damage the product.
- Remove the battery from the product when it is not in use.
- Do not wet nor incinerate the battery, nor to deform the terminal.



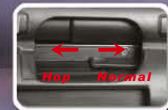
4 Connect the connector.



5 Assemble the handguard.



6 Insert the handguard locking pin.



Wrong Too much hop-up (Return the lever toward Normal)

Right Best position

Wrong Not enough hop-up (Sliding the lever toward Hop)

Load the BBs & Install Magazine



1 Pull the lever forward to release the magazine.



2 Open the cover of magazine and load G&G 5.95mm BB pellets into the magazine.



3 After the BB pellet had been loaded, close the cover and turn the gear on the bottom of the magazine until it clicks.



4 Set the magazine upward. Connect firmly till a click sound is heard.



When not firing the gun or during storage, always set the selector to the Safe Mode and attach the protective cap on the muzzle.



The gun will fire one shot each time as pulling the trigger.



The gun will fire automatically while the trigger remains pulled.

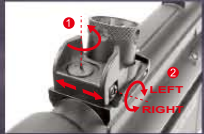

Rear sight adjustment



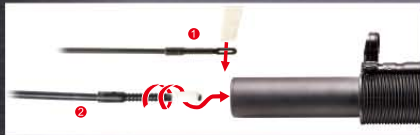
Loosen the rear sight fixing screw and turn the adjusting screw with a screwdriver.



Turn for adjustment. Use the small size for precision shooting.

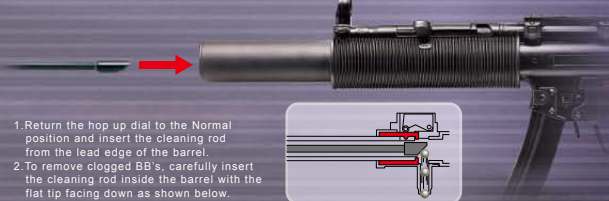


Maintenance when pellet speed becomes low



1. Drop a few drops of silicone oil or Teflon oil from the pellet entrance. Insert BB pellets into the magazine and fire around 1 to 2 magazines.
2. To complete the cleaning, use the cleaning rod (with cotton), to remove excess oil.

Removing clogged pellets



1. Return the hop up dial to the Normal position and insert the cleaning rod from the lead edge of the barrel.
2. To remove clogged BB's, carefully insert the cleaning rod inside the barrel with the flat tip facing down as shown below.

WARNING

- Do not jam the cleaning rod into the barrel by force.
- Should the BB's remains inside the barrel after following the instruction above, with the protection cap over the barrel, point the gun to a safe direction, and discharge any loosened BB's in semi-automatic mode.

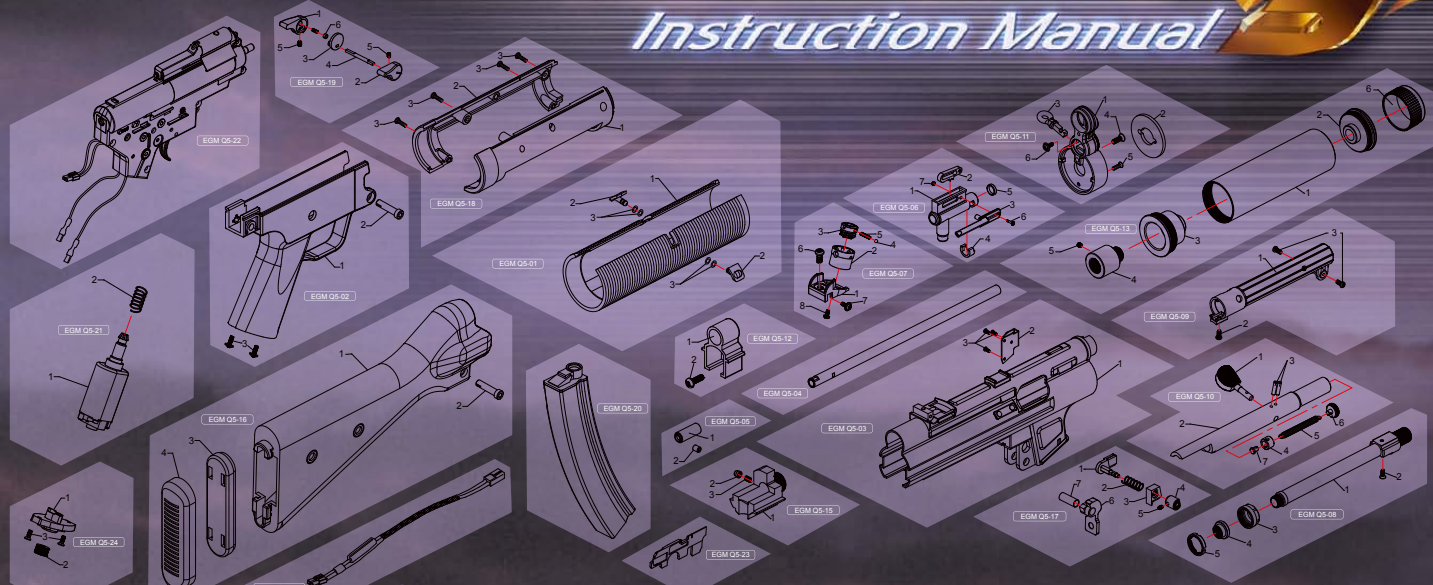

New Blow Back Pneumatic system

True to the faith of mimicking real life firearms, G&G is proud to present its new Pneumatic Blow Back system to its line of airsoft guns. Conventional airsoft blowback utilizes tow hook springs to mimic real life bolt actions, which often lead to excess wear and tear and poor reliability in the gear box. To alleviate the problem of conventional systems, G&G has independently developed the Pneumatic Blow Back system; a piston driven, gas operated mechanism to better mimic real life bolt actions. This new technique utilizes compressed air to move the bolt, which enables the action without adding extra stress to the gearbox. This class leading system represents a significant milestone in the airsoft industry.
