



ENGAGE

To engage the safety, pull up the trigger safety. The gun is not ready to fire.

DISENGAGE

To disengage the safety, push down the trigger safety. The gun is ready to fire.

3-1. BB LOADING

- 1. Pull the magazine follower down and hold the magazine follower.
- 2. Insert BBs into the magazine and make sure the pellets is fully dual-lined (have no space between).

S17/S18C Magazine MAX Capacity = 23 rounds S19 Magazine MAX Capacity = 20 rounds

3-2. FILLING THE GAS

- Push the Gas canister nozzle into the charging valve. Make sure the canister is in vertical position when charging.
- 2. Filling magazine until gas overflows from charging valve.

3-3. CHECK THE PISTOL

- 1. Remove the Magazine.
- 2. Pull back the slide with free hand and lock it.
- 3. Check the chamber is no BB bullets.



CAUTION:

BEFORE SHOOTING AND AFTER SHOOTING MUST CHECK THE CHAMBER.

WARNING:

DO NOT PUT YOUR FINGER INTO THE CHAMBER, IT'S DANGEROUS.

3-4. SETTING MAGAZINE

- 1. Place the magazine into the magazine well.
- 2. Push the magazine up until clicks into the locked position.
- Pull the magazine done to assure that it has been locked in place.



YOU MAY EXPERIENCE A DELAY ACTION IF SURROUNDING TEMPERATURE DROPS BELOW 20°C/60°F. REMEMBER, DO NOT EXPOSE MAGAZINE DIRECTLY UNDER THE SUN OR INCINERATE THE MAGAZINE, IT MAY CAUSE SURSTING, IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED TO EMPTY GAS FROM MAGAZINE AFTER SHOOTING. BE SURE TO AVOID DIRECT GAS CONTACT WITH EYES OR SKIN WHEN THE GAS IS BEING RELEASED, IT WILL CAUSE FROSTBITE.

WARNING:

- 1. CHECK CANISTER FOR ANY CRACKS OR LEAKS BEFORE USING.
- 2. DO NOT EXPOSE CANISTER OVER $40^{\circ}\text{C}/\ 104^{\circ}\text{F}$
- 3. DO NOT LEAVE CANISTER DIRECTLY OVER
- 4. DO NOT BOIL CANISTER.
- 5. KEEP CANISTER AWAY FROM DIRECT SUNLIGHT.



3-5. CLICK

- 1. Pull back the slide with free hand and lock slide.
- 2. Press slide stop lever and allow slide to move forward.
- 3. The finger of the shooting hand remains outside the trigger guard.
- 4. The pistol is now secured and ready to fire.
- 5. After the last round of fire, the slide will be lock.

4-1. DISASSEMBLY

- 1. Press the magazine catch to remove the magazine.
- 2. Pull back the slide and allow the slide to spring forwards.
- 3. Pull down the Slide lock and push the slide forwards and separate slide from the receiver.
- 4. Take the recoil spring assembly out of slide.
- 5. Push the barrel set forwards, raise it and pull the barrel set backwards out of slide.
- 6. Pull the inner barrel set out of out barrel




CAUTION:

3-6. SEMI & AUTO FIRING

Select firing mode by push the firing selector:



G18C





Up for semi-auto, Down for full-auto. Lock the slide and move the device to switch Semi / Auto mode.















Disassembly & Cleaning

Variable Hop-UP System

4-2. MAIN COMPONENT



5-1. HOP-UP SYSTEM

- 1. Pull back the slide and allow the slide to spring forwards.
- 2. Pull down the slide lock and push the slide forwards and separate slide from the receiver.

4-3. CLEANING

1. Receiver

Apply gear grease over all faces contact with slide assembly. Spray high viscosity silicone oil on the hammer set if encounter a sluggish hammer movement. Use the high viscosity silicone oil to lubricate all rubbe contact area.

2. Slide:

Apply gear grease over all faces contact with frame assembly's metal parts.

Spray high viscosity silicone oil inside the piston. You could do it by pulling piston forward, and spray some into the internal space.

3. Magazine:

Use the high viscosity silicone oil to lubricate all rubber contact area.

4. Barrel & HOP UP system: Spry silicone oil to the chamber for 0.5 to 1 sec and Use patch holder to clean the inner barrel.

5-2. ADJUST THE HOP-UP

- 1. Turn the adjustment to backwards to give bullets more hop up.
- 2. Turn the adjustment to forwards to give bullets less hop up.
